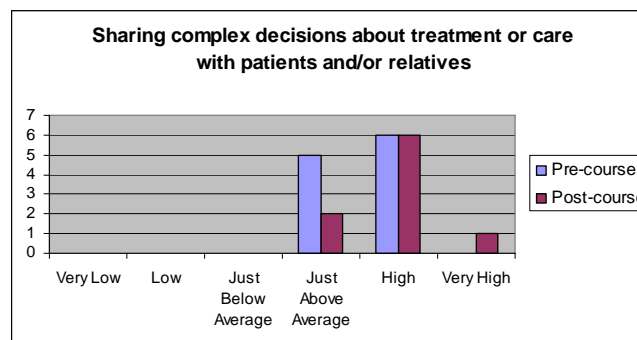
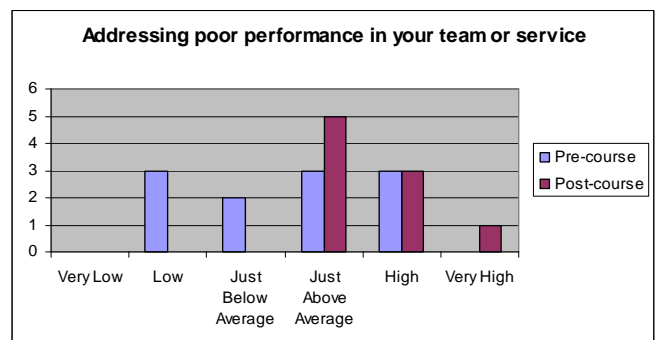
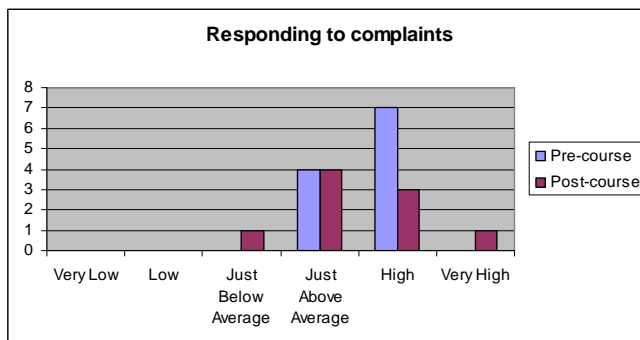
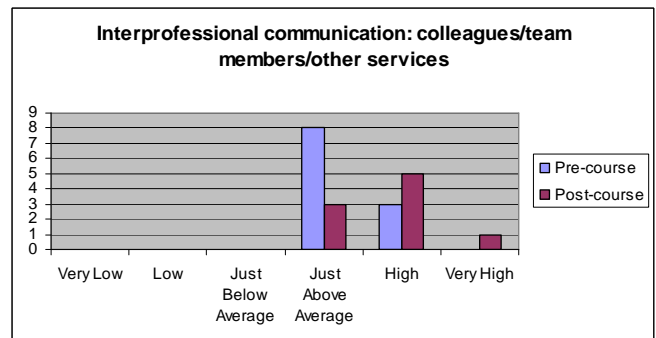
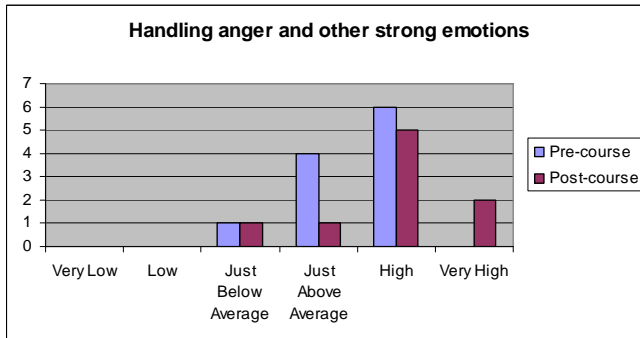


Communication Challenges Workshop for Consultants Edinburgh - August 2013
