
CLINICAL COMMUNICATIONS TUTOR TRAINING WORKSHOP

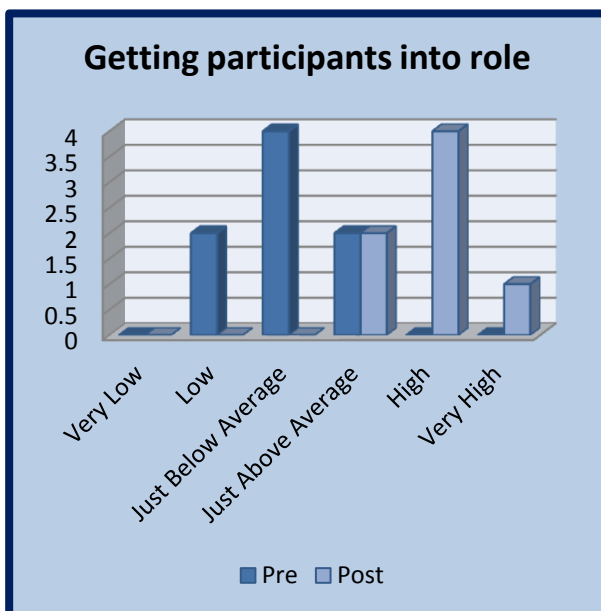
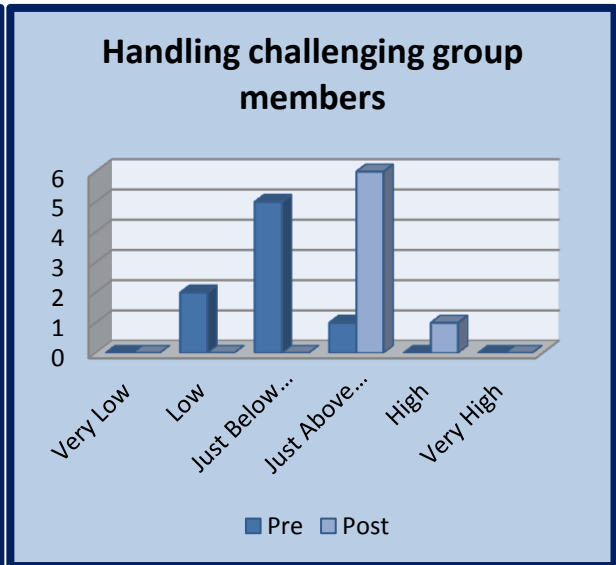
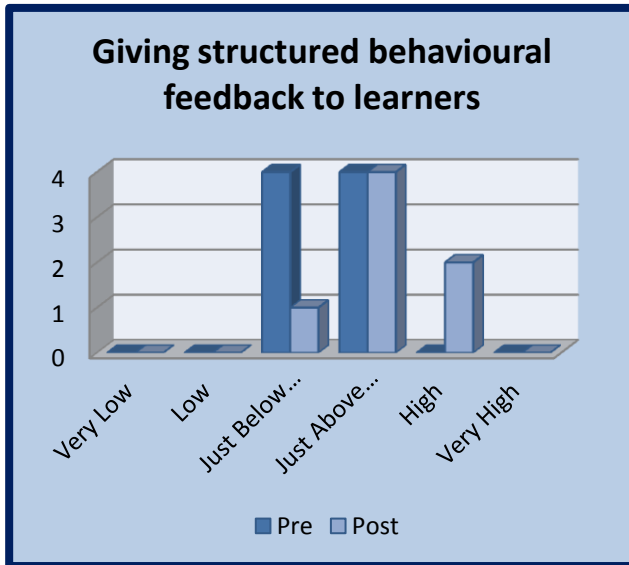
13TH AND 14TH JUNE | WESTERN GENERAL HOSPITAL

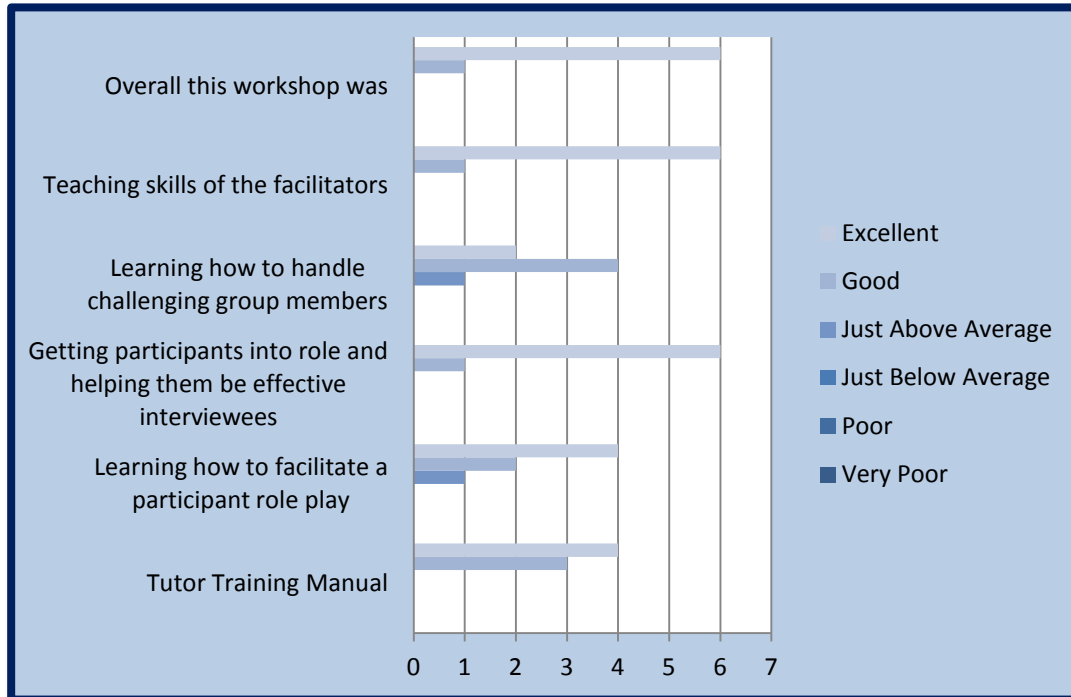
PARTICIPANT CONFIDENCE RATINGS PRE & POST WORKSHOP

Participants completed online pre-workshop and post-workshop measures of their confidence in managing different communication training challenges. For each challenging scenario confidence ratings were higher after the workshop than before the workshop

SUMMARY OF EVALUATIONS

The workshop was highly rated by all participants. Participants valued the experiential teaching methods. Participants found trying out and testing different communication skills and strategies through role play simulations highly effective. In particular they appreciated having the opportunity to try out different roles as participants within roles play scenarios and as facilitators. Some noted the particular value of being able to critically observe others in the group working as facilitators.
