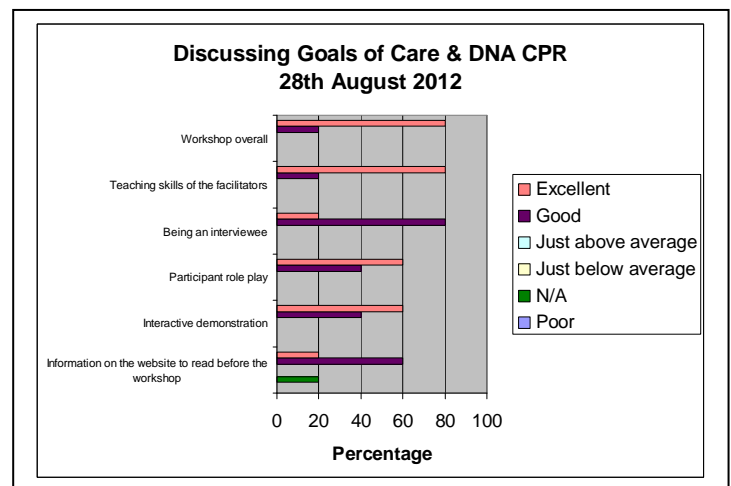
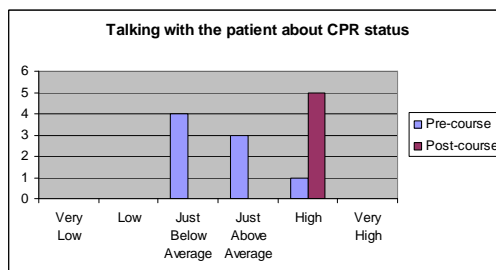
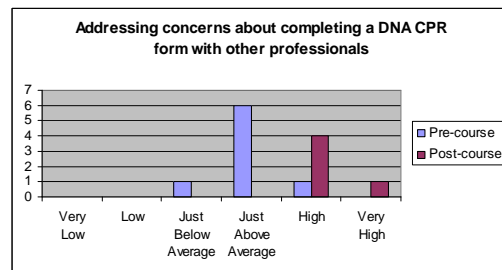
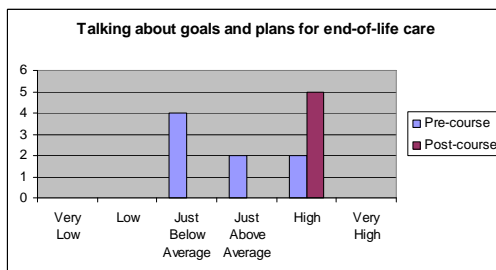
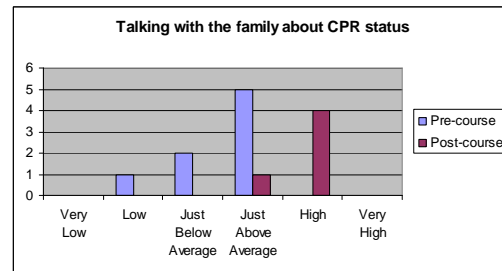
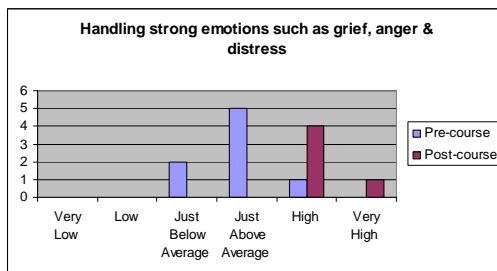


**‘Communication Challenges in Clinical Practice’
